MORNING TIME

Send this note in your child's lunchbox or backpack today: "Treat others the way you want to be treated. Today is a great day to show respect!"



DRIVE TIME

Pick a mealtime to go out and grab something on the go! When you arrive, have your child go into the restaurant and make the order for everyone, focusing on respect. Tell them to speak clearly and make eye contact. When they finished the order, tell them all the ways you saw them use respect!



MEAL TIME

Ask a kid: Would you rather be president or a rock star? Why?
Ask a parent: If you could have dinner with someone important, who would you choose and why?



BED TIME

Read Matthew 8:5-13. Talk about a person you respect and share the things that you do to show you respect that person. While we're called to respect everyone, the most important person to respect is God! What are some ways you can respect God? Ask God to help you show respect to Him and to all the people around you.
